Cobble Beach Golf Links

The terms "links" and "links-style" are often misused in contemporary golf, but they meet their true expression in Doug Carrick's design at Cobble Beach. Located on the shores of Georgian Bay, near Owen Sound, this semi-private course presents the pleasurable excitement golfers associate with such seaside sites as St. Andrews, Pebble Beach, and Ballybunion. Over land that tumbles and rolls, rising to present shoreline views and cascading to the bluffs above the water's edge, Carrick has laid out a par 72, 7, 100-yard challenge that will test the finest players, with four sets of tees to accommodate golfers at all skill levels. The Nantucket-style clubhouse offers sweeping views of Georgian Bay. Featuring a boutique-style inn, with 10 luxury suites, a full-service Spa and The Sweetwater Restaurant that offers a dining room, bar and a patio. Just north of the clubhouse there are 5 private cottages, each complete with two bedrooms, two bathrooms, a living area with a queen size sofa bed, wet bar and stunning views of Georgian Bay. The course and club are the center-piece of a planned lifestyle community with a variety of options for those who want to call Cobble Beach their home.

Challenge yourself with a round at one of Ontario's most popular resort courses - Monterra Golf. Designed in 1989 by Tom McBroom, Monterra Golf is a formidable challenge for golfers and is one of the many recreation experiences to be found at the four-season resort and the Village at Blue Mountain. A traditional links course, it encompasses rolling bent grass fairways, razorback mounding, 86 bunkers, seven lakes, ravines, and spectacular elevated tee shots. In addition to the course itself, Monterra Golf offers a full service golf shop, deli and bar and an 18,000-square-foot practice area. The course has received numerous awards and recognition, including certification by the Audubon Society's Cooperative Sanctuary Program.

SCOREGolf magazine in 2008 called BlackHorse “one of the top new courses in Ontario and one of the best golf values in the province.” London Free Press golf writer John Herbert ranked it as the “Best Public Course in Southwestern Ontario” with the “Best Greens.” The 6,836-yard track east of Kincardine and west of Walkerton/Wingham has sensational bentgrass greens and tees, impeccably cared for fairways and a stunning layout. Two holes carved out of a former gravel pit are among the most spectacular, offering dramatic views and the challenge of playing around a 5-acre spring-fed lake. The course has 6 ponds, 50 bunkers and a minimum of 4 sets of tees on every hole. BlackHorse is in a quiet rural setting about an hour’s drive from Kitchener, Waterloo, Guelph & Owen Sound. Play it once and you’ll understand why it’s getting rave reviews. The facility offers a state-of-the-art 30 acre practice range featuring all turf tees. Green fee players, members, tournaments and buses are welcome.



Experience a true test of golf surrounded by the natural beauty of the Nottawasaga Valley. Considered to be a golfer's paradise, the Nottawasaga Resort is home to two courses that offer tight fairways, dramatic elevations and demanding challenges that are perfect for serious and recreational players alike. Known for its twists and turns, the 27-hole Nottawasaga Course features tight fairways that will challenge the accuracy of your swing as you negotiate your way through mature trees and the winding banks of the Nottawasaga River. The 18-hole Ridge golf course features spectacular varied elevation changes, tall trees, and large undulating greens offering a demanding but fair challenge to all golfers.

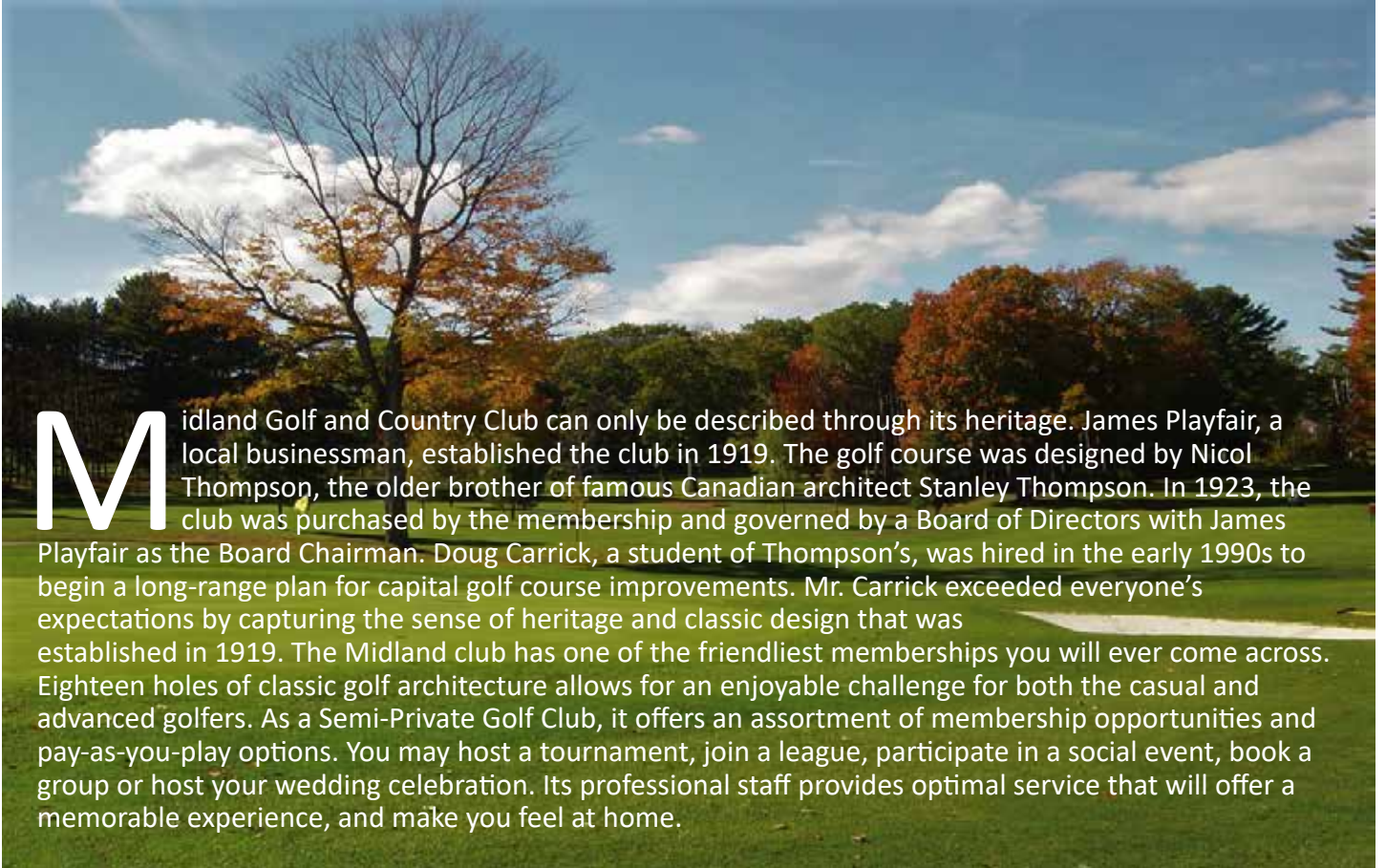

Midland Golf and Country Club can only be described through its heritage. James Playfair, a local businessman, established the club in 1919. The golf course was designed by Nicol Thompson, the older brother of famous Canadian architect Stanley Thompson. In 1923, the club was purchased by the membership and governed by a Board of Directors with James Playfair as the Board Chairman. Doug Carrick, a student of Thompson's, was hired in the early 1990s to begin a long-range plan for capital golf course improvements. Mr. Carrick exceeded everyone's expectations by capturing the sense of heritage and classic design that was established in 1919. The Midland club has one of the friendliest memberships you will ever come across. Eighteen holes of classic golf architecture allows for an enjoyable challenge for both the casual and advanced golfers. As a Semi-Private Golf Club, it offers an assortment of membership opportunities and pay-as-you-play options. You may host a tournament, join a league, participate in a social event, book a group or host your wedding celebration. Its professional staff provides optimal service that will offer a memorable experience, and make you feel at home.

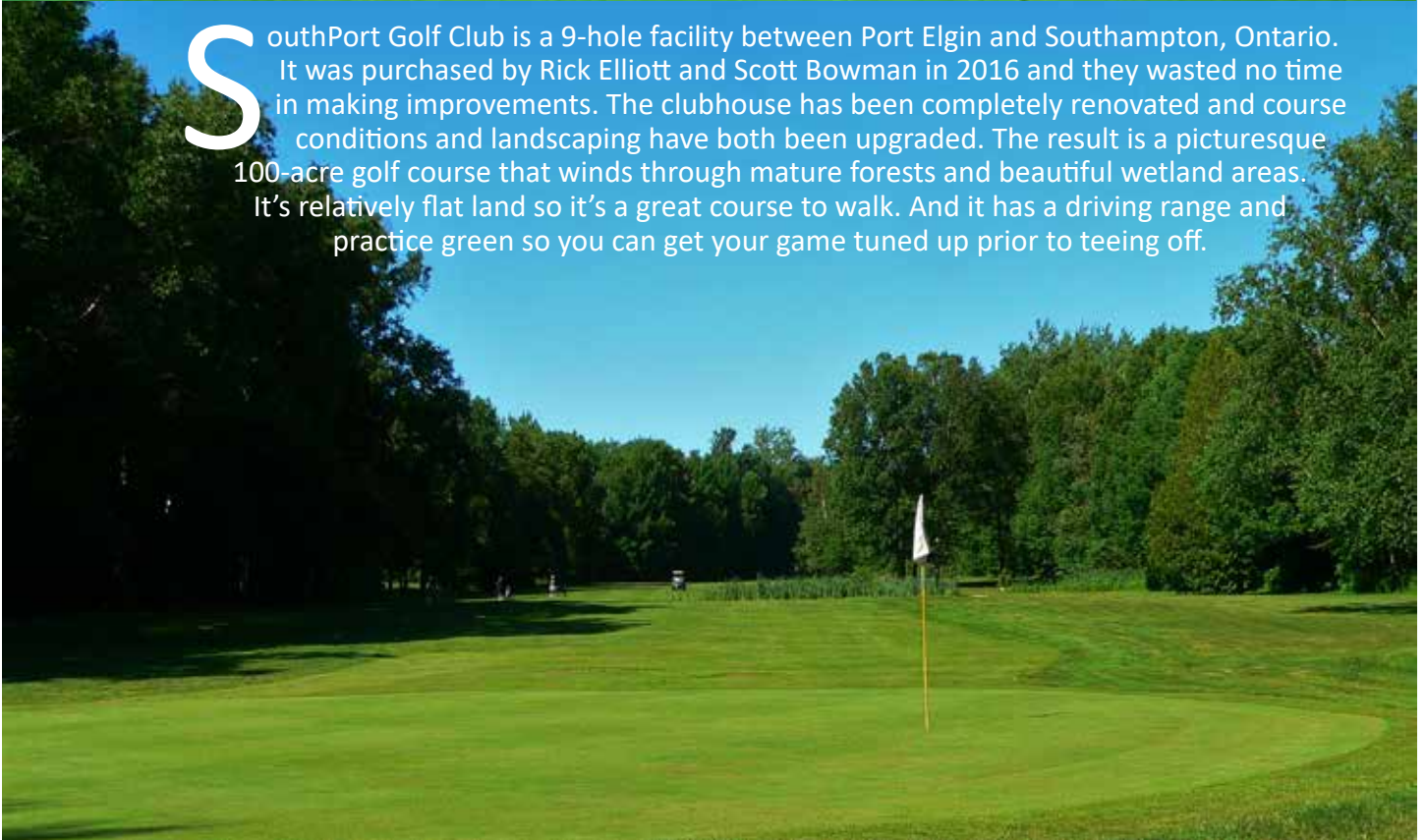

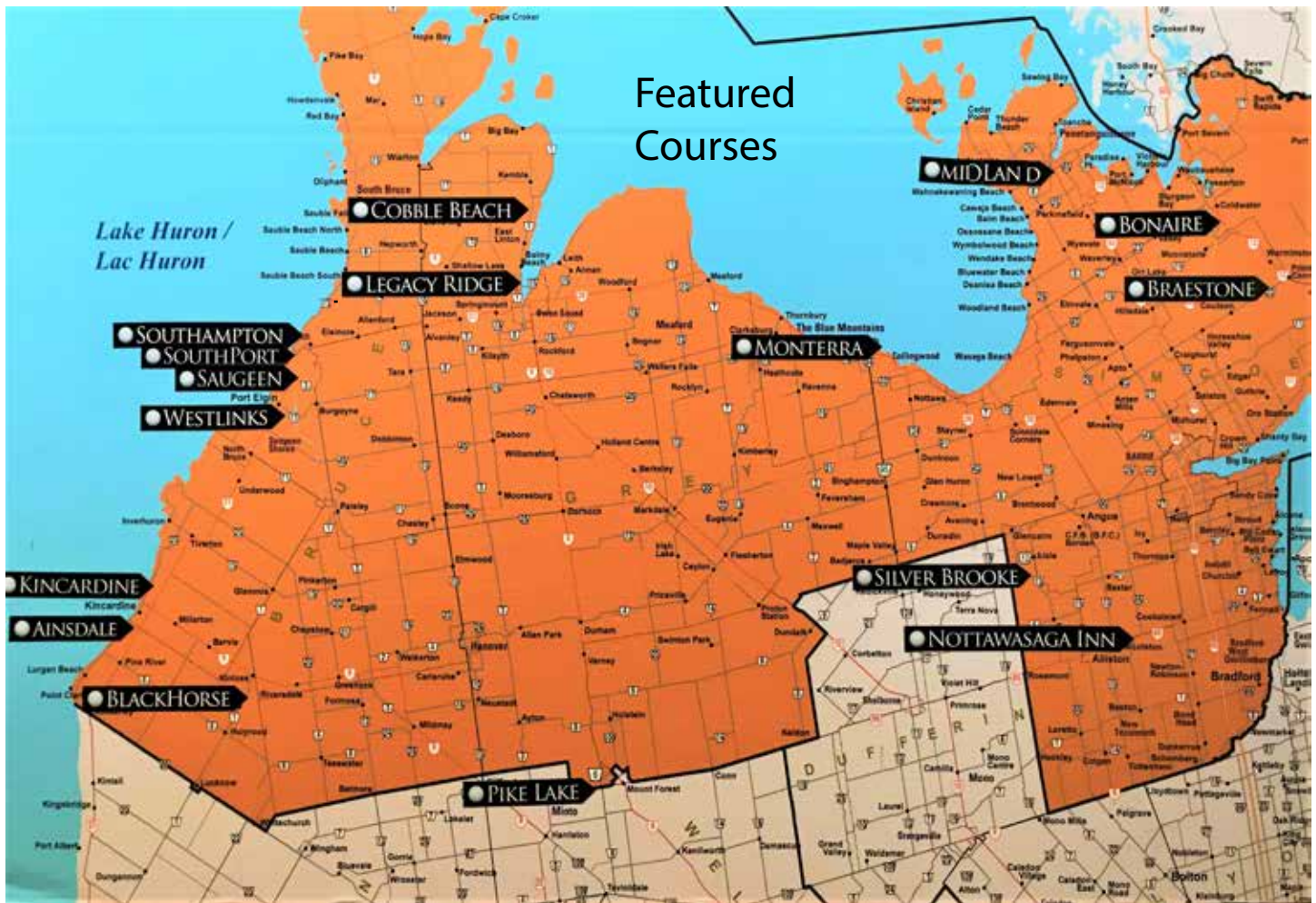

SouthPort Golf Club is a 9-hole facility between Port Elgin and Southampton, Ontario. It was purchased by Rick Elliott and Scott Bowman in 2016 and they wasted no time in making improvements. The clubhouse has been completely renovated and course conditions and landscaping have both been upgraded. The result is a picturesque 100-acre golf course that winds through mature forests and beautiful wetland areas. It's relatively flat land so it's a great course to walk.
