

Aces run in the family

Regular readers of this magazine may recall a story in the 2024 Summer/Fall edition about a golfer who aced all five par 3s at his home course during his golf career.

That golfer was Shane Barker and his amazing feat at Legacy Ridge Golf Club near Owen Sound was accomplished over 20 years.

But he is not the only one in the family who knows how to make a one on a par 3. His wife, Deborah Barker, scored two aces in the matter of a few days this year to bring her ace total to four, just one shy of her husband's total.

Her 3rd career ace came on Aug. 10 at Legacy's 8th hole while her 4th came three days later on the 3rd hole at Mitchell Golf Club during a tourney. With Deborah's back-to-back brilliance, the Barker household now boasts a remarkable 9 aces!

How is this possible? Well, it helps that Shane plays five times a week and Deborah six times.
The Owen Sound couple began golfing in 1990.

"With a young family we decided that we needed to do something together as a couple. So it was either ballroom dancing or golf," Shane said.

He describes Deborah's swing as beautiful, smooth and fluid. Deborah got her love for the game from her mother, Evelyn Townend, who played golf right up to age 85 and had an ace of her own.


"The motto we inherited from Evelyn is 'just go to


